THE ONCHAN DOG CONTROL BYELAWS 2007

These Byelaws came into operation one year ago and the Commissioners are disappointed to note that dog owners are not complying with their responsibilities under the law.

Dog faeces must be removed from any highway that consists of or comprises a carriageway, which includes back lanes, footways, pavements and grass verges, within its district and from the open spaces and beaches described in Schedule 3 of the Byelaw.

Copies of the Dog Control Byelaws are available from the Commissioners Office.

Contravention of the Byelaws is an offence by the keeper of the dog, punishable by a fixed penalty of £50, or, upon summary conviction, a fine of up to £1,000.
