The ENP currently comprises national and local politicians, and officers from the Youth Justice Team, Drug and Alcohol Team, Community Safety Unit, Force Intelligence Bureau, Fire and Rescue Service, Laxey Commissioners, Lonan Commissioners, Braddan Commissioners, Onchan Commissioners, Douglas Corporation, DoLGE, Dept of Transport, and Dept of Education  
Through information sharing, the partners assist each other in the formulation and development of strategies for reducing crime and disorder within the Eastern Neighbourhood.

Chairman of the Commissioners, Mr Derek Crellin JP, said that he looked forward to assisting in the ongoing development of a local partnership plan that will meet the demands of the Onchan community, and added, “As members of the ENP we will seek to robustly address any problems within our district, such as anti-social behaviour, that adversely affect the community’s quality of life.”
