## ARE YOU RETURNING TO THE ISLAND FROM THE UK OR FURTHER AFIELD

Residents who are travelling off-Island must ensure that they abide by the current Government Regulations.

Residents can register to enable non-essential return travel to the Isle of Man, **if they are prepared to self-isolate for 14 days on their return.**

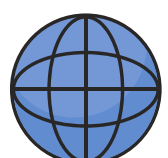
You do not need to register to leave the Island - anyone is free to leave at any time.

Island residents wishing to return must complete a landing Form to provide your arrival details within 48 hours prior to arriving back on the Island. The Landing Form will request arrival details including the address at which you will be isolating on your return, as well as your contact number, and a health declaration.

**Random and unscheduled checks will be made on those returning to the Island to ensure compliance with the self-isolation requirement helping to protect the wider Island community.**

## COMMISSIONERS HOUSING

Those residents living in property owned by Onchan District Commissioners, must inform the Housing Office of their travel arrangements as soon as possible, prior to departure off-Island and confirm the date/time of arrival back to the Island.

**You must self-isolate for 14 days on return to the Island.**

During the isolation period you must not make physical contact with any member of staff, tenant or visitor and must not enter any communal areas including laundry areas.

**Should you be experiencing any difficulties or concerns in this regard, please contact the Housing Team as we may be able to provide further advice or assistance.**
