



Statutory Notice: DOI 170

Manx Grand Prix and Classic T.T. (Temporary Regulation of Traffic) Notice 2017

The Department of Infrastructure gives notice of the following road traffic restrictions made under Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 and all other enabling powers.

1 Commencement and expiry

- (1) This Notice will come into operation on 18 August 2017 and expire on 8 September 2017.
- (2) The requirements and effect of this Notice will be in force at all times from **9.30 a.m. on Friday 18 August 2017** until **4.30 p.m. on Monday 4 September 2017** except where specified as otherwise.

2 Prohibition of traffic

- (1) The roads and car parks contained within Nobles Park, Douglas, will be closed to vehicles from the Unnamed Road at its junction with Dukes Avenue up to a point 52 metres in a north-easterly direction from the Pavilion as indicated by signage and barriers, during the period specified in paragraph (2).
- (2) The period commences at 9.30 a.m. on 18 August until 6.00 p.m. on 8 September 2017.
- (3) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to vehicles approved or authorised by the organiser or the Department of Economic Development.
- (4) A prohibition of through traffic will be imposed on Cloughbane Walk, Ramsey, at its junction with the A18 Mountain Road and a person must not cause or permit any vehicle to use that section of road for access or egress to or from the Mountain Road.
- (5) Pedestrians are prohibited on the T.T. Access Road, Douglas and Braddan, from its junction with the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road to its junction with River Vale, Braddan Hills, Braddan, and a person must not enter or proceed on that road.
- (6) A prohibition of cycling will be imposed on the A18 Mountain Road from its junction with Ramsey hairpin to its junction with the Creg ny Baa Back Road and a person must not ride a pedal cycle on this section of road.

3 Temporary speed limit

A temporary speed limit will be imposed on the roads specified in Schedule 1 and a person must not cause or permit a vehicle to travel in excess of the speed limit specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

4 Imposition of one-way etc.

A one-way road traffic restriction will be imposed on the roads specified in Schedule 2 and a person must not cause or permit a vehicle to travel otherwise than in the direction specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

5 Suspension of one-way

The one-way traffic restriction shall be suspended on the following roads whilst the roads known as the TT Mountain Course are closed for races during the closure periods specified in Schedule 2 of the Manx Grand Prix and Classic TT Road Races Authorisation 2017 —

- (a) Park Avenue, Douglas, for its entire length.
- (b) Cronkbourne Road, Douglas, from Cronkbourne Avenue to Quarterbridge Road, Douglas.
- (c) Albert Terrace Lane, Ramsey, from Westbourne Road to a point abutting the western boundary of the rear of the property numbered 1 Albert Terrace.
- (d) Christian Street, Ramsey, from its junction with Albert Road to its junction with Queen's Pier Road.

6 Suspension of parking

Parking will be suspended on the south-east side of the A2 New Road, Laxey, and no person may cause a vehicle to wait —

- (a) from a point adjacent to property no. 45 in a northerly direction to the southern boundary of the bus stop adjacent to Laxey Commissioners Office; and
- (b) from its junction with Church Hill to its junction with the railway crossing at the Mines Tavern.

7 No waiting restriction of traffic

A no waiting restriction of traffic will be imposed on the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 and a person must not cause or permit a vehicle to wait during the times specified in column 2 of that schedule.

8 Imposition of Clearway

A person must not cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the following roads whilst the roads known as the TT Mountain Course are closed for races during the closure

periods specified in Schedule 2 of the Manx Grand Prix and Classic TT Road Races Authorisation 2017 –

- (a) TT Access Road from its junction with the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road to its junction with River Vale, Braddan Hills, Braddan.
- (b) Creg-nyBaa Back Road, Onchan, from its junction with the TT Course at Creg-ny-Baa for a distance of 500 metres.
- (c) Orrisdale Road, Kirk Michael, between the southern boundary of the old railway bridge and the path to Rhencullen, a distance of 210 metres.

9 Exemptions

- (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the following vehicles shall be exempt –
 - (a) Emergency service vehicles;
 - (b) vehicles approved or authorised by the Department of Infrastructure;
 - (c) vehicles acting under the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform; and
 - (d) any other vehicles specified as exempt in the Notice.
- (2) The exemptions specified in paragraph (1) shall not apply to Article 4.

SCHEDULE 1

TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT

[Article 3]

1 ROADS	2 SPEED LIMIT
A1 Douglas to Peel Road between a point 307 metres west of Trollaby Lane for a distance of 910 metres in a westerly direction, to the existing 30 mph sign	40 mph
A1 Douglas to Peel Road between a point 170 metres north-west of the Ballavitchel Road and a point 52 metres north-west of the boundary to the property formerly known as the Highlander	50 mph
A1 Douglas to Peel Road between the end of the existing 50 mph speed limit at Greeba and the existing 30 mph speed limit at Ballacraigne	50 mph
A3 Castletown to Ramsey Road between a point 20 metres south of the entrance to Ballamenagh House and a point 250 metres north of the junction with the B10 at Barregarrow Crossroads	60mph
A3 Castletown to Ramsey Road between a point 38 metres north-east of its junction with the Ballamooar Farm Road, Ballaugh, and a point 126 metres west of the Sulby crossroads	50 mph
A18 Mountain Road between a point 130 metres east of the Ramsey Town Boundary to a point 150 metres south-west of the Gooseneck	50 mph
A18 Mountain Road between a point 350 metres north-west of its junction with the B12 Creg-ny-Baa Back Road to the existing 40 mph speed limit at Hillberry	60 mph
A2 Whitebridge Hill between a point 25 metres south of the entrance road to Ballakilmartin Farm and a point 100 metres north of its junction with Begoade Road.	40 mph

A5 New Castletown Road, Douglas, both sides from the existing no waiting restriction a point 155 metres from its junction with the A1 Douglas to Peel Road to its junction with Saddle Road.	No waiting at any time
River Vale, Braddan Hills, Braddan, from its junction with the TT Access Road to its junction with the A23 Braddan School Road.	
Groves Road, Douglas, south-west side from the zebra crossing opposite the National Sports Centre car park to its junction with Springfield Avenue.	
Vicarage Road, Douglas and Braddan, both sides from its junction with Saddle Road, in a westerly direction to its junction with Kirby Farm Industrial Estate.	
Strang Road, Braddan, east side from its junction with the A1 Douglas to Peel Road to its junction with Camlork Place.	
A3 Castletown to Ballacraigne Road, Ballacraigne, east side from its junction with the A1 Douglas to Peel Road for a distance of 100 metres in a southerly direction	
Ballig Bridge, German, north-west side from its junction with the A3 at Ballig Bridge for a distance of 100m	
Ebeneezer Lane, Laurel Bank, German on the north side of the road from its junction with the A3 for a distance of 30 metres	
B8 Sulby Claddagh Road, Sulby, north-west side from but not including the parking places located at the gable end of the property known as Ginger Hall to a point adjacent the property known as "Allandale Farm"	
Ballure Road, Ramsey east side from its junction with Ballure Promenade to the lane at the side of the property known as 'Silverdale'	
Ballaragh Road, Laxey, both sides from its junction with the A2 for a distance of 30 metres	
Glencrutchery Road, Douglas, both sides from its junction with the entrance to the Borough Cemetery to the Pelican Crossing at its entrance to the St John Ambulance Headquarters	
Upper Dukes Road, Douglas, both sides from its junction with Dukes Avenue to its junction with Victoria Avenue	
Victoria Avenue, Douglas, north-east side from its junction with the E14 Unnamed Lane (opposite its junction with Upper Dukes Road) to Victoria Road	
TT Grandstand, Douglas, the entrance and exit splays to the Pit Lane adjacent to Glencrutchery Road, including the entrance splay to the Pit Return Lane fronting Nobles Park and in the parking place at the entrance to the Borough Cemetery	No waiting at any time from one hour prior to the road closure period referred to in Schedule 2 of the Manx Grand Prix and Classic TT Road Races Authorisation 2017 until those closures take effect
