Subject:	Site Plan Demarcation – Refurbishment of houses at Nursery Avenue

Request is for the following

- “(i) The “site plan” including the red line demarcation for the storage of vehicles, access to and from , including storage of materials used during the refurbishment of the houses in Nursery Avenue; plus
- (ii) The closing site documents to return the site back from the contractors to Onchan Commissioners. The site in question was located beside Kissacks walk opposite the back entrance to Onchan Club House through to the opposite end located on Nursery Avenue.”

To enable me to consider and process the request it is assumed that the reference is to the refurbishment works that were carried out in 2014. It is confirmed that officers have carried out a reasonable search of the Authority’s records and that no such site plan or closing site documents can be found.

To try and assist identify where the site was located it is understood that the contractors had a temporary secure compound on the North West corner of the School Road Recreation Field which was accessible by vehicle via Nursery Avenue and not the access road to the rear of the Onchan Club House.
