**Re: Traffic Regulation Orders – Sea Cliff Road and King Edward Road**

This letter is to notify you that the Department of Infrastructure is intending to implement new Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs), for Sea Cliff Road and Kind Edward Road.

We are proposing to extend the No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Lines) on the property side of Sea Cliff Road for approximately 32 meters. This order will remove parked vehicles off the bend, which will allow larger vehicles to pass safely and improve forward visibility.

It has also become necessary, due increased parking of vehicles all day, to introduce two passing places along King Edward Road. One section is proposed for outside No. 45 King Edward Road of approximately 32 meters. The other will be situated on the seaward side of King Edward, after the Port Jack shops heading towards Douglas for approximately 32 meters.

In addition to the proposed Double Yellow Lines (DYLs) we are also proposing to introduce a small two hour disc parking zone outside Port Jack shops. The purpose of this is to ensure a constant turnover of parking spaces for customers to the businesses.

Please find enclosed three plans of the proposals, and I would welcome any comments you may have in relation to the proposals by the 16<sup>th</sup> June 2017. Please bear in mind that the Department has to address the concerns of all road users and as such individual requirements may not be able to be accommodated.
