# TT Road Races 2015



# ROADS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC

**Notice is given** that the Department of Infrastructure has made Orders under the Road Races Act 1982 & the Highways Act 1986. The Tourist Trophy Road Races Order 2015 permits the Promoters to hold practices, races and parades during the TT Festival period. If weather or other circumstances require races, practices or parades to be delayed or postponed then crossing points may be open under the control of Marshals at such times as the Clerk of the Course may specify.

#### 1. ONE WAY ON THE A18 MOUNTAIN ROAD

The A18 Mountain Road will be closed from Barrule Park, Ramsey to Creg-ny-Baa between 9.30 am and 4.30 pm on Friday 29 May 2015 and will then re-open to ONE WAY traffic from the Ramsey Hairpin to the Creg ny Baa for the whole TT period until 9.30 am on Monday 15 June 2015 when it will close for the removal of signs and re-open at 4.30 pm to TWO WAY traffic.

#### 2. ROADS CLOSED

The A18 Mountain Road from Barrule Park, Ramsey to the Bungalow will close ONE HOUR and 15 MINUTES before the closure of the remainder of the TT course during Practice Week and FORTY FIVE MINUTES before the closure of the remainder of the TT course during Race Week (Bungalow to Creg-ny-Baa will close 15 MINUTES later than this time), and again after completion of ALL PRACTICES AND RACES for a further period of up to ONE HOUR, and re-open to traffic as a one-way road.

The main roads known as the TT COURSE will be CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC for the 2015 TT Practices, Parades and Races as follows –

**3. DELAYED AND POSTPONED RACES** - In the event of adverse weather conditions etc the start of any race, including a Parade, may be delayed.

ROADS OPEN not later than 9.30pm except the Mountain Road which will be not later than 10.30pm.

If racing is postponed to Sunday 7 June 2015 the Mountain Road will close at 12.45pm and the rest of the TT course at 1.30pm until not later than 6.00pm. The Mountain Road will re-open One-Way no later than 7.00pm.

4. Notification of delayed and postponed closures will be given in the news bulletins on local radio.

- **5. CROSSING PLACES AND ACCESS CORRIDORS** In any interval, the Clerk of the Course may authorise traffic to cross or proceed along the Course at the places specified below, at such times as they may specify:-
- Douglas, St Ninians crossroads between Ballaquayle Road and Ballanard Road
- Douglas, Bottom of Bray Hill between Stoney Road and Tromode Road
- Douglas, Peel Road between the Quarterbridge and Strang Road, Union Mills
- Crosby, between Old Church Road, Eyreton Road and Ballavitchel Road
- Michael, Barregarrow crossroads
- Kirk Michael, between Douglas Road Corner and Station Road and

- Glen Road at Ballaugh Bridge
- Lezayre, Sulby Glen crossroads
- Ramsey, between Christian Street and Westbourne Road
- Ramsey, between Lheaney Road and Barrule Park
- Onchan/Douglas, between Signpost Corner and Bedstead Corner
- Onchan/Douglas, between Governor's Road, Victoria Road and Second Avenue

- **6. ACCESS ROAD TO THE INSIDE OF THE TT COURSE** Restricted vehicular access to the inside of the course, including Noble's Hospital, for cars and small vans below 3,500kg, is via the A5 New Castletown Road near the junction with the Quarterbridge Roundabout. The Access Road is narrow with passing places and traffic is controlled. No pedestrian access is permitted.
- 7. ROADS OPENING The TT Course will be re-opened for traffic by an official motor vehicle displaying a notice "Roads Open" proceeding along the Course upon the completion of the Practices and Races, and by the passing of such vehicle the part of the Course so passed is open for traffic. For the Mountain Road the official motor vehicle will display "Roads Open One Way".
- **8. DO NOT ENTER A PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED AREA** during road closure periods. The TT Road Races Order 2015 defines the TT Course and details the definition of and locations of Prohibited and Restricted Areas. Plans of the Prohibited and Restricted areas may be inspected at the Welcome Centre, Sea Terminal, Douglas. Ancillary traffic management arrangements may be inspected via Highway Services, Sea Terminal.
- **9. PARKING RESTRICTIONS** still apply do not park on double yellow lines or inconsiderately. There will be a no waiting restriction on the TT Course 1 hour before road closures. Please do not park in the marshals' lay-bys on the Mountain Road.
